The USAFCENT/SG office has visibility of what conditions have traditionally done well at specific locations theater-wide and is responsible for maintaining a database for USCENTCOM/SG.

If member also requires a fly waiver renewal, then the AMS must be written out. Ensure all diagnoses are listed in the diagnosis section, including all medication(s). CC letters are not required for Annual ALCs, as long as the condition as remained stable. It is NGB/SG's discretion to request CC letters.
