### Faculty Emergency Guide

1. Keep dangerous supplies out of reach. Scissors, bulletin board tacks, glue - all things that shouldn't be easily accessible for preschool-aged kids. Make sure to keep any sharp objects, choking hazards, poisonous materials and other potentially hazardous supplies on a high shelf or locked away in a cupboard.
