Compare countries - Hofstede Insights
The Hofstede model of national culture consists of six dimensions. The cultural dimensions represent independent preferences for one state of affairs over another that distinguish countries (rather than individuals) from each other. The country scores on the dimensions are relative, in that we are all human and simultaneously we are all unique.

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In successive studies these Hofstede Cultural Dimensions were identified for 76 countries. Each country has a scale from 1 to 100 for each dimension. The higher the score, the more the dimension in question emerges in the culture. Hofstede's Six Dimensions of Culture, Psychologist Dr Geert Hofstede published his cultural dimensions model at the end of the 1970s, based on a decade of research. Since then, it's become an internationally recognized standard for understanding cultural differences. Hofstede studied people who worked for IBM in more than 50 countries.

These are called dimensions of culture. Each of them has been expressed on a scale that runs roughly from 0 to 100. Dimension maps of the world: Individualism.
