LEUSTATIN, cladribine, injection is available in singleuse vials containing 10 mg (1mg/mL) of cladribine, a - chlorinated purine nucleoside analogue. Each millilitre of LEUSTATIN Injection contains 1 mg of the active ingredient, cladribine, and 9 mg (0.15 mEq) of sodium chloride as an inactive ingredient. The solution has a pH range of 5.5 to 8.0.
