It derives from and is the successor to OS/390, which in turn followed a string of MVS versions.[NB 2] Like OS/390, z/OS combines a number of formerly separate, related products, some of which are still optional. z/OS has the attributes of modern operating systems, but also retains much of the older functionality originated since the 1960s and still in regular use—z/OS is designed for backward ...
